## COMING SOON-STATLER STITCHER

We are very excited to announce the addition of a state-of-the art Gammill Statler Stitcher to the shop. Our machine is on order. Once the machine has been delivered and we have had a few weeks to practice, we will begin taking in quilts for quilting. We know that the first quilt quilted for a client will be a milestone, so we are going to celebrate with a special contest. From now until the day that we start quilting for the public, you can enter your name in a drawing to be the first quilt quilted by our Statler Stitcher for FREE! Each day that you make a purchase over \$20, you can drop your name into the drawing. (\*One entry per purchase and per day. \*Quilting service only—does not include backing, batting, or binding. \*Edge-to-Edge Quilting only—no custom. \*Maximum size 100" x 100".)

## PIGS ROAST SATURDAY, JUNE 27TH

PIGS stands for "Projects in Grocery Sacks," and we all have them. Set aside this day to work on one of the projects that you have in progress or on your "someday" list. Bring your project in a grocery sack (paper or plastic), and get a coupon good for \$5 off any purchase you make that day (minimum \$5 of course).

The cost for the day is \$20 and that includes lunch. This is going to be a fun and exciting day. What could be better than getting away from the distractions at home and spending a day sewing with quilting friends? Sign up early to reserve your spot.

## SKILL SERIES SAMPLER

Each month, we present a new skill and you can practice that skill on a sampler block. You can attend just the classes that you need or would enjoy. As your stack of sampler blocks grows, so will your skills and confidence.

\*Class #10—Foundation Piecing-Pineapple Block will be Tuesday, June 2nd from 6:30-9:30 pm or Wednesday, June 3rd from 10:30 am—1:30 pm.

\*Class #16-Working with wedge shapes-Dresden Plate will be Monday, June 8th from 10:30 am—1:30 pm.

\*Class #11—Machine Applique will be Wednesday, July 1st from 10:30 am—1:30 pm or Tuesday, July 7th from 6:30—9:30 pm.

Class #17—Setting Your Quilt Blocks will be Monday, July 13th from 10:30 am—1:30 pm.

\*Class #12—Needleturn Applique will be Tuesday, August 4th from 6:30-9:30 pm or Wednesday, August 5th from 10:30 am—1:30 pm.

Class #18—Borders will be Monday, August 10th from 10:30 am—1:30 pm.

## APPLIQUE GROUP

We have formed an appliqué stitching group. The group will meet on the first Friday of each month from 10:30 am—1:30 pm. While this is not a beginning appliqué class, if you have taken an appliqué class or done a little bit of appliqué, it is a great venue to work on projects, to share tips and techniques, and to enjoy the company of other quilters. There is no charge for this stitching group—just bring your projects and have fun.

## QUILT FINISHERS

The 2009 finishers are already off to a good start with 80 finished projects reported so far this year. The Quilt Finishers meet together for show-and-tell of our finished projects and to continue to work on getting those UFO's (unfinished fabric objects) done. The group meets from 10 am—2 pm on the third Friday of every month. Cost to join is \$10 for the entire year. You can join at any time. If you can't attend the meetings, you can just drop by and show us your completed projects.

\*Any quilted object is eligible

\*Finished is bound and labeled

\*Projects started at any time are eligible, but they must be completed in 2009.

\*If you quilt for others, no client quilts

You will put your name into a drawing for every project you finish. The club will run throughout 2009, and we will hold the drawing party in January of next year. We will provide a wide variety of prizes. Of course, the real prize is getting those projects done and sharing the accomplishment with other quilters.

## INTERNATIONAL MYSTERY IS BACK

Just in time for summer "vacations" we are bringing back the international mystery. The trips will be on the second Friday from 10 am—1 pm. Cost is \$20. You can order your optional kit when you enroll.

Friday, June 12th from 10 am—1 pm we will travel to Australia. The optional class kit will be available in either Bondi Beach (Aqua & Green) or AyeOutback Sunset (Orange & Red).

Friday, July 10th from 10 am – 1 pm we will travel to Scotland. The optional class kit will be available in either Thistle (Lavender and Purple) or Family Tartan (Red and Green).

*We offer a **frequent shopper card** that is good for \$20 off after you reach \$200 in purchases. The only exclusions are sales tax, gift certificates, classes, and discounted items. Be sure to turn in your printed cards to switch to our automated tracking system.*

*Discounts cannot be combined. When multiple discounts are involved (ex. Sale fabric & a birthday discount), then you would get the greater of the two.*

*We offer a birthday discount good for half of your age. For example, 52 years of age would get 26% off. The discount is good 1 week before to 1 week after your birthday, and you must announce your birthday before your sale is complete.*

**FAT QUARTER DAY 3RD SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH-Fat Quarters \$1.75-regularly \$2.75**

**KILL THE BOLT SALE**—on the first Saturday of every month, buy all remaining fabric on any bolt and receive 25% off of that bolt.

## JO'S LITTLE WOMEN CLUB-NEW SESSION IN JULY

Each month we will meet together to work on a Jo Morton designed quilt. We will be starting Series 8 with features one lap sized quilt that we will work on over 4 months and 2 doll sized quilts. At the start of the club, you will purchase a punch-card for 24 fat quarters at 20% off. You can select your fat quarters from any of the Jo Morton fabric lines, and you can select all of them at the beginning or a few at a time. The fat quarters will be used to make all of the blocks in the series of quilts, so you will only need to purchase additional fabric for your borders, backing, and binding.

The cost of the club is \$81.50 (including sales tax) for which you get 24 fat quarters, six months of Jo Morton patterns, and six workshop sessions.

The club members will meet on the third Monday of each month from 10 am—2 pm. The meetings are a fun time to show off your finished top from the prior month and to begin work on the current month. The best part is seeing the different fabric and color choices. If you can't attend one of the meetings, you can pick up the pattern at the shop anytime during the month.

## STRIP CLUB 4TH SATURDAY

We have had great response to our strip club quilts this past year. For those of you who haven't discovered this yet, strip club features quilts made using 2 1/2" strips. Because the strips are pre-cut, these quilts are usually fast and fun to make. This year, we will debut the quilt on the fourth Saturday of each month. If you come to the shop on the fourth Saturday, you can see the quilt and purchase the strip set for that quilt for \$35. After the fourth Saturday, any remaining strips from that quilt will be available for purchase for \$40, so you can save \$5 by visiting us on Strip Club day. You can choose to make just the quilts that you like—there is no ongoing obligation.

The June strip club will feature fun, bright colors. Saturday, June 27th.

The July strip club will feature Moda fabrics in soft blue, rust, and peach. Saturday, July 25th.

The August strip club will be presented on the fourth Saturday. By that time, we will all be ready for fall, so this quilt will feature batiks in fall colors. Saturday, August 22nd.

## CLASS POLICIES

- \*Class fees are due when you register.
- \*Your cancellation of a class with less than 1 week's notice will result in forfeiture of the class fee.
